Essential Product Information: Presentation: Curanail 5% Nail Lacquer contains 5% w/v amorolfine. **Indications:** Mild distal and lateral subungual Onychomycoses caused by dermatophytes, yeasts and moulds limited to up to 2 nails. **Dosage and Administration:** Adults Only – Apply to the affected finger or toe nails once weekly (see summary of product characteristics for full technique). Treatment duration depends on intensity and localisation of infection. Generally, six months (finger nails) and nine to twelve months (toe nails). Not recommended for use in patients under the age of 18. **Contra-Indications:** Hypersensitivity. No experience in pregnancy and lactation, it should therefore be avoided. **Precautions and Warnings:** Avoid contact with eyes, ears and mucous membranes. Patients with predisposing conditions such as peripheral circulatory disorders, diabetes mellitus and immunosuppression should be referred to a doctor. Patients with nail dystrophy and destroyed nail plate should also be referred to a doctor. **Side Effects:** Adverse drug reactions are rare. Nail disorders (e.g. nail discoloration, broken nails, brittle nails) may occur. These reactions can also be linked to the onychomycosis itself.

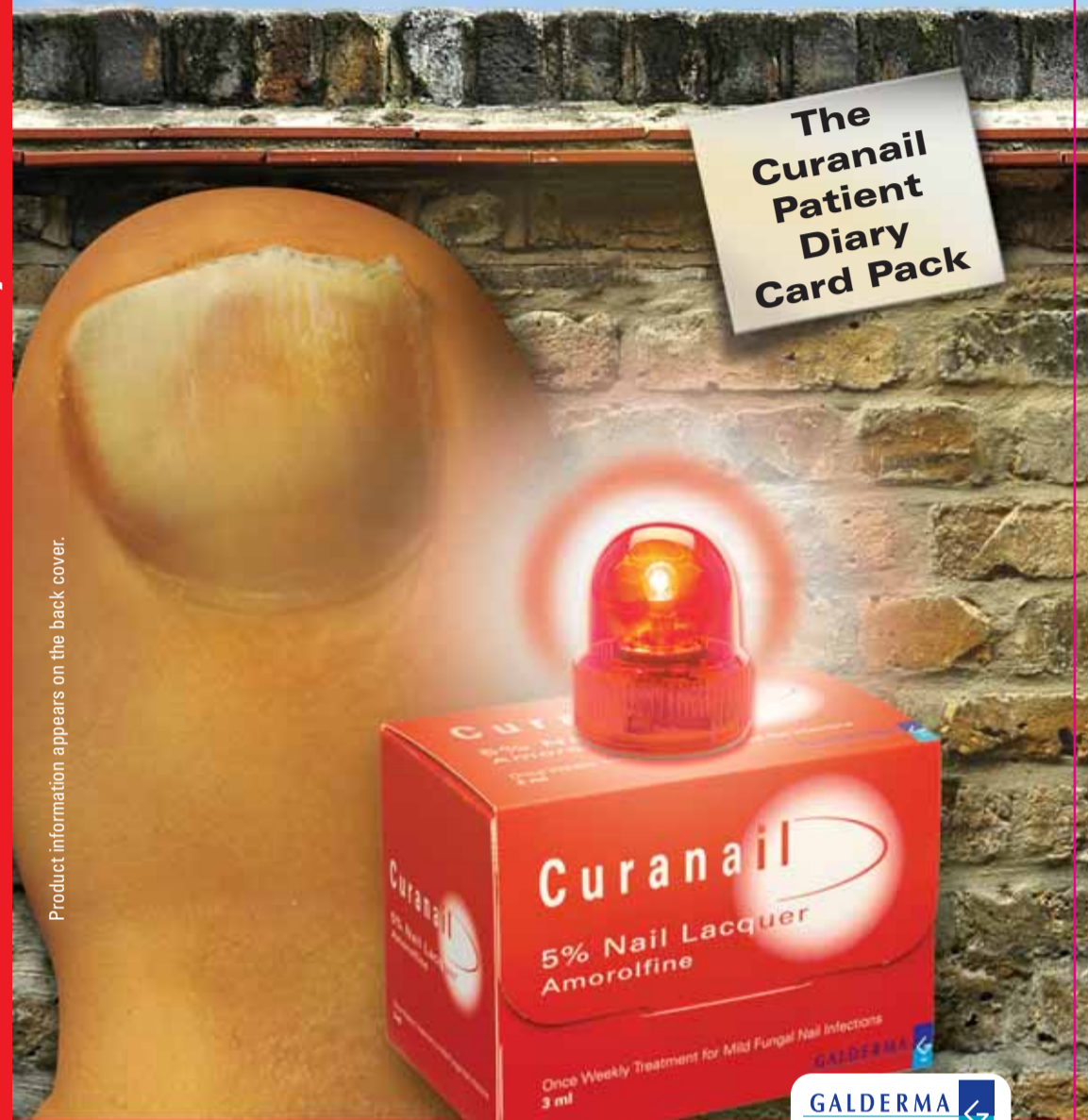
